KĀKAHU IA RĀ

Black pants, shorts, skirts, tights, black shoes, and black socks purchased from a store of your choice. Plain black hats purchased from a store of your choice. The Hoani Waititi logo can be printed at Logo-Land, West City. Thermals, singlets and any other garments worn under the uniform for extra warmth must be completely black if visible.

WHAREKURA - only the black hoodie or the black Waititi puffer jacket are permitted to be worn

over kura polo. Travel uniform (red jacket/black polo/black BLK/Dynasty track pants are not permitted for everyday wear at Wharekura

NOT PERMITTED AT KURA

Denim, jandals, gumboots, logos other than Hoani Waititi. Black means completely black, navy blue means completely navy blue. Hoani Waititi merchandise not listed above eg. Kapa Haka or Poitarawhiti hoodies are not permitted to be worn daily. Travel uniform (red jacket/black polo/black BLK/Dynasty track pants are not permitted for everyday wear at Wharekura

SPARE KĀKAHU FOR ALTERNATIVE ACTIVITIES AT KURA

Students are required to change into appropriate, alternative clothes for all sports and messy activities. This includes appropriate shoes. It is helpful for students to develop the habit of bringing a change of clothes every day. There is a sports shirt available to purchase from the Kura office, this is optional. Students are required to wear their daily uniform at all times when they are not participating in sports or messy activities.

KOTI WHERO/HŪTU HĀKINAKINA

Red Waititi jackets are available for purchase but not compulsory for Kura Tuatahi haerenga, Kura Tuatahi students (years 1-6) are permitted to wear the red Waititi jackets to kura on a daily basis. These jackets are optional for Kura Tuatahi.

WHĀNAU KĀKAHŪ

Whānau members are permitted to wear the Waititi puffer jackets, however, whanau are not permitted to wear the Black Waititi hoodies; as these are specifically for taura of the kura. Black Whanau jackets are available via placing an order at the tari or emailing Kōkā Michayle directly at marago-kemp@hoaniwaititi.school.nz

Please note; orders for Raukura and Waititi Whānau jackets must be approved by Pāpā Hare before order and purchase. Delivery times may vary.

TE PŌTURI KI TE WHAI KĀKAHU KURA - DELAYS IN SUPPLY OF UNIFORMS

Dynasty Sport supplies all the kura specialty items. The Kura is currently discussing solutions with Dynasty to have a regular supply of these uniforms, as previously it has taken up to 12 weeks for a delivery.

KI TE HIAHIA ĀWHINA TE WHĀNAU - SHOULD WHĀNAU REQUIRE ASSISTANCE

The kura is open to helping whānau with their tamariki uniform needs if whānau are facing hardship. These circumstances can be directed to Pāpā Hare and Kōkā Rangitārewa to arrange
